### PROJECTS

#### Trance Party Project

Trance party attendees are interested in getting into a trance, or are curious about trance and altered states. Often, attendees will use inebriates such as Ecstasy and alcohol in ways which are counter-productive for the producers of the events. The TRF Trance Party Project aims to offer an understanding of trance to trance party goers in the form of a presentation, workshops, literature, and offer effective ways to self-induce trance while maintaining positive control. This trance empowerment reduces the potential harms associated with out-of-control drug and alcohol usage.

#### Drug Policy Project

Discovering and developing a uniform drug policy which is practical, which reduces harm and increases public safety is not an easy undertaking. Yet, public policy makers need such guidance if there will ever be the possibility of solving the “drug problem”. The Drug Policy Project advocates policy based on scientific knowledge and increased personal responsibility. Promoting such radical changes needs concerned experts on trance able to commit to a presence at various meetings of public policy makers around the world.

#### Refugee Project

Various United Nations projects are concerned with helping refugees around the world who arrive in refugee camps in shock, grief, angry, fearful and needy on a variety of levels. We know that such people are highly suggestible and can be easily manipulated and abused in undertaking criminal activities. Our aim is to educate refugees about how important trance sensitivity is, to be able to counter trance abuse and to defend against various forms of refugee exploitation.

#### On-line Course Development

The Trance Institute is developing a series of on-line courses in order to build a professional group of trance analysts and consultants able to provide trance related services to the general public. This is a long-term project requiring teachers and educators willing to commit to building this important part of the TRF.
